

CONTAIN YARD WASTE FOR WEEKLY PICKUP



Edgewater encourages residents to bag or contain yard waste. ALL bagged or contained yard waste is picked up EVERY Wednesday, excluding holiday weeks. Picking up individual piles of sticks and other small vegetative items slows removal. Contained yard waste can be picked up and emptied into the trucks much more quickly.

The City of Edgewater's refuse service includes the collection of your garbage, recycling and yard waste. Even old furniture, household appliances and tires get picked up.

<u>Garbage is collected</u> twice per week, either on Monday & Thursday or on Tuesday & Friday. Edgewater provides each home with one <u>Refuse Container</u> for garbage collection for residents use in placing garbage by the street. Excess garbage may be placed in plastic bags or other approved container.

<u>Recycling is collected</u> by Southard's once per week, on one of your garbage collection days. Recycling should be placed loose in the bin and not bagged. Phone Books, Magazines, Newspaper & Inserts, Junk Mail, Brown Paper Bags, Cardboard, Aluminum, Tin & Steel Cans - with or without labels; Plastic Containers [#]1,2,3,4,5,6 & 7; and Glass Bottles & Jars - with or without labels, may all be recycled. Caps can be left on plastic bottles but food can contaminate recyclables, so rinse containers before recycling.

Place garbage and recycling containers by the street, in front of your home by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Containers can also be placed out the evening before collection day and should be removed by 11:00 p.m.

<u>Loose Yard Waste</u> is picked up on a continual route system, which may take several weeks. <u>Bagged or contained Yard Waste</u> is collected every Wednesday, except holiday weeks. Place Yard Waste by the street in front of your home, not blocking your mailbox, driveway or drainage swale, in piles 4'x4'x4' or smaller.

If you contract with a tree service to trim or cut down a tree, make sure disposal is included in their price, because ALL <u>Contractors</u> are responsible for disposal of the waste generated in the services they provide. Edgewater may charge you for disposal if a contractor does not remove their waste.

<u>Appliances. Furniture and Tires</u> go out for collection on Wednesdays, except during holiday weeks. If items are not picked up, you will be placed on a list for collection within a few days. Leave items out for collection so you don't miss the pick up. Tires are limited to four (4) per home, per year. All items for disposal must be out to the street by 7:00 a.m.

Some items do not go in your garbage. Edgewater does not accept <u>solvents</u>, <u>paint</u>, <u>auto fluids</u>, <u>household/pool chemicals or any combustible items</u> for collection. Empty containers from these products may be placed with your regular garbage. Paint cans must be empty and completely dried up before disposal. <u>Hazardous Waste</u> may be disposed of at the Tomoka Landfill, located at 1990 Tomoka Farms Road in Port Orange - (386) 947-2952.

<u>Used Motor Oil</u> is accepted for disposal at the following locations in Edgewater:

- Advanced Auto Parts 1714 S. Ridgewood Ave.
- AutoZone Auto Parts 1720 S. Ridgewood Ave.
- O'Reilly Auto Parts 1952 S. Ridgewood Ave.

<u>Hypodermic/IV Needles</u> cannot be placed in your garbage. You MUST use a "Sharps" disposal container. Contact the New Smyrna Beach Health Department at (386) 424-2061 for more information about disposal containers.

<u>Medical Waste</u> that has NOT come in contact with bodily fluids, such as IV fluid bags or oxygen tubing, may be disposed of with regular garbage, but Edgewater CANNOT collect any Medical Waste in red or yellow bio-hazardous bags.

FLOOD FACTS

No home is completely safe from flooding and flooding can be a devastating event. Just one inch of water in a home can cause more than \$25,000 in damage.



CONSIDER THESE FLOOD FACTS:

- In the past 5 years, all 50 states have experienced floods or flash floods.
- Everyone lives in a flood zone. It is just a question of whether you live in a low, moderate or high risk area.
- Just a few inches of water from a flood can cause tens of thousands of dollars in damage.
- A car can easily be carried away by just two feet of floodwater.
- Most homeowner's insurance policies do not cover flood damage.
- You are eligible to purchase flood insurance if you are a renter, homeowner, or business owner and your property is located in a community that participates in the National Flood Insurance Program. Edgewater participates.
- It may take 30-60 days after purchase for a policy to take effect, so it is important to buy insurance before a storm approaches.
- Even though flood insurance is not federally required, anyone can be financially vulnerable to floods. People outside of mapped high-risk flood areas file nearly 25% of all National Flood Insurance Program insurance claims and receive one-third of Federal Disaster Assistance for flooding.
- Edgewater participates in the Community Rating System (CRS) and residents can qualify for an insurance premium discount.
