the maximum building coverage and/or maximum impervious coverage as established for the respective zoning district.
Storage sheds of 200 sq. ft. or less and not utilized as a garage may be located 5 feet from rear and side property lines.
Accessory buildings shall be limited to 2 per parcel.
The total sq. ft. of all accessory buildings and/or storage sheds shall not exceed 60% of the total sq. ft. of the principal or
primary structure in residentially zoned areas, with the exception of attached and detached aircraft hangars permitted
in residential districts adjacent to airport taxiways; and properties zoned Agriculture and or contain an agriculture
exemption as recognized by the Volusia County Property Appraiser.
All accessory structures located in residentially zoned areas exceeding 350 sq. ft. or visible from a public roadway and
located on a parcel of less than 5 acres shall be consistent with the primary structure in architectural design, exterior
construction materials or façade treatment, roofline and color.

Accessory buildings may be required to have paved aprons and/or stabilized pathways as required by
the Land Development Code/Environmental Services Department depending on structure size,
placement, and potential use. Ask a permit technician for more details.
It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all accessory structures comply with code.
