Do you know what's happening around the City?

- Secured over \$16 million in grants for stormwater and canal improvements to reduce flooding.
- Completed improvements to three city parks (Lake & Alice Neighborhood, Rotary and Menard May).
- New boat ramp being planned on the Indian River (south of Hacienda Del Rio).
- Extending reclaimed water access to conserve potable water and reducing the number of dirt roads to improve water quality.
- Improvements to improve resilience to severe weather (YMCA, Water and Wastewater Plants).
- Improvements to police department facilities and equipment and establishment of Citizen's Academy.
