Re: 2024 Water Service Line Inventory

As part of a nationwide effort required by the EPA, the City of Edgewater will be conducting a Water Service Line Inventory during the Spring and Summer of 2024. The focus of this inventory will be to document the types of materials used in water service lines that were installed in 1989 and earlier, which is about half of all water services in the City.

Staff from the City's Environmental Services Department will be conducting the field work related to this effort beginning in late March through September 2024. The field work will generally include inspecting inside and around the water meter box, which is typically found in the front yard of your home. In some cases, all of the information can be obtained from within the meter box. In other cases, Staff will need to dig holes in the vicinity of the meter box to expose the pipe material. Environmental Services personnel conducting inspections will attempt to keep the disruption to a minimum and fill the holes back in level by the end of the workday.
