### 3. Project Summary

- Project location is at the City of Edgewater's Whistle Stop Park, located at 651 Roberts Road, Edgewater, FL 32141.
- The project shall be substantially complete in 300 days and final completion within 30 days of substantial completion or 330 days total.
- The Whistle Stop Park Improvements project involves a complete redevelopment of the existing 14 acre Whistle Stop Park. Improvements include a splashpark, playground, a new skatepark, restrooms, improved lighting, a ½ mile walking trail, fitness kiosks, a volleyball court, a dog park, greenspace and new tennis courts, basketball courts, racquetball courts, parking, landscaping and stormwater management system.

### 4. Important Items

- There are some minor plan changes per a recently issued SJRWMD permit. Quantities for Line Item 15 In-line Drain and Line Item 16 15" PVC have changed, in addition, Line Item 71 Mitigation Planting has been eliminated. Revised plan sheets, a revised bid schedule and the SJRWMD permit will be posted on Demandstar soon.
- Scheduling, planning and control of staff and sub-contractor's staff is the bidders responsibility.
- The Contractor will be responsible for securing City permits for construction; however, the permit fees will be waived.
- With the close proximity to a school and recurring vandalism in the park the property will need to be secured with a temporary lockable chain link fence for the duration of the project. Securing equipment and materials will be the responsibility of the Contractor.
- Work hours shall be 7:00 am to Sunset, 7 days a week.
- Liquidated damages shall be \$500 per day.
- Cost estimate is \$3.5 Million
