General Summary:	This position works under general supervision, performing skilled diagnostic and mechanical work. This staff's effort focuses on the maintenance and repairs of heavy-duty vehicles and equipment, yet may assist in the repair and maintenance of light and medium vehicles and equipment. Description:	<p>Performs preventive maintenance and repairs of heavy equipment, including but not limited to sanitation trucks, fire trucks, dump trucks, loaders, backhoes, walking excavators, and heavy mowers.</p> <p>Maintains and repairs small engines and related equipment to include but not limited to pumps, string trimmers, ground maintenance equipment, and compressors.</p> <p>Performs complex diagnostic procedures on vehicles in order to determine necessary repairs or identify repairs in the process of preventive maintenance.</p> <p>Performs preventive maintenance and repairs of light and medium vehicles and equipment, including but not limited to police vehicles, pickup trucks, zero-turn mowers, and utility vehicles.</p> <p>Repairs include engines, transmissions, brake systems, electrical systems, cooling systems, hydraulic systems, mechanical systems, and the repair or replacement of tires.</p> <p>Operates vehicles and equipment as required for diagnosis and the insurance of proper operating condition post-repair</p> <p>Must furnish own tools for the performance of duties.</p> <p>Maintains city-supplied shop tools, machinery, and equipment to ensure proper functions.</p> <p>Assists fleet personnel in diagnostics and repairs of vehicles and equipment.</p> <p>Maintains work areas in a clean and orderly manner to promote effective and safe operations.</p> <p>Performs other duties as assigned.</p> <p>May assume the position of acting Fleet Superintendent as needed.</p> <p>Foster positive employee relations and employee morale on a City-wide basis.</p> <p>May be required to return to work to assist with emergency management preparation, response, and recovery activities.</p>
