General Summary:	Under general supervision, performs repair and maintenance of a variety on City gas- and diesel-powered construction equipment, vehicles, small engines and related equipment. Reports to the Public Works Superintendent
Description:	Assists the Superintendent with such duties as selecting and allocating employees, assigning work, training, maintaining standards and acting on employee problems Maintains compliance with the City's safety program pertaining to job and mechanics
	Coordinates City's fleet maintenance program for all assigned City vehicles, including administration of assigned departmental repair budgeting
	Responsible for the repairs and maintenance of heavy equipment such as dump trucks, road graders, front end loaders, backhoes, compactors, mowers, tractors, etc.: repairs and maintains City vehicles as assigned; includes the repair of engines, drive chains, transmissions, brake systems, electrical systems, cooling systems, hydraulic systems, mechanical systems, etc.
	Performs diagnostic procedures on vehicles in order to determine necessary repairs or maintenance
	Orders parts necessary for completion of duties, and/or designs and fabricates new items as needed
	Runs service calls as needed to repair or transport disabled vehicles
	Modifies equipment as necessary, may prepare and paint equipment/vehicles as required
	Maintains work areas in a clean and orderly manner to promote effective and safe operations
	Schedules fleet maintenance repair/maintenance jobs for the mechanic
	Maintains and repairs small engines and related equipment such as pumps, weed eaters, grounds equipment, compressors, control units, etc.
