GENERAL SUMMARY

Under general supervision, the position is responsible for installing, repairing, and maintaining both Wastewater Treatment Plant and Water Treatment Plant assets. These assets include sewer collection systems, pumps, electrical circuitry, and other mechanical systems located at various municipal locations. The position reports to the Wastewater Collections Superintendent.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: (all duties may not be performed by all incumbents)

Maintains electrical panels using the ability to troubleshoot such components as transformers, relays, phase monitors, alternators, breakers, motor starters, alarms, float switches, submersible as well as non-submersible motors, and any other equipment of the electrical operation of a lift station.

Performs electrical repairs, maintenance, and repairs at municipal facilities including the Water and Wastewater Treatment Plants.

Maintains, troubleshoots, and repairs the City's wastewater collection system, to sustain the proper operating conditions of sewer lift stations, sewer lines, manholes, air release valves, check valves, plug valves, and any other equipment used in wastewater collection.

Installs, maintains, and repairs various electrical fixtures and equipment. This includes outlets, lights, motor starters, motors, and electrical panels. Wires buildings and makes additions to existing wiring.

Assists and trains skilled workers of related trades in general electrical safety, troubleshooting, and maintenance work.

Will be required at times to contact repair/service facilities for parts, quotes, and repair status of equipment.

Uses vacuum truck for opening blocked sewer lines, degreasing lift stations, and assisting wastewater plant in some duties.

Performs confined space entries and uses various confined space equipment.

Participates in on-call rotation and assists other collection employees in emergencies.

Foster positive employee relations and employee morale on a City-wide basis.

May be required to return to work to assist with emergency management preparation, response, and/or recovery activities.

May perform a variety of miscellaneous duties such as:

Inspects manholes, sewer lines, lift stations, and any other work done by contractors to ensure proper work ethics and to uphold City policies and guidelines.

The normal operating condition of sewer collection machinery.
