	Performs routine sampling of booster stations, interconnects and MRT sample site.
	Responds to Customer complaints and questions as it relates to water quality and other utility matters.
	Assists the Director, Water Plant Manager and Field Operations Superintendent with Precautionary B Water notices in compliance with the City's written plan and the Volusia County Health Department.
	Provides monthly report of water usage and residual levels to Water Plant Manager.
