Description:	<p>Maintains records for flushing and irrigation totals.</p> <p>Performs flushing program and assists with valve exercising program.</p> <p>Assists Water Plant Manager and Lab Quality Administrator in collection of water samples throughout the distribution system in accordance with the written sampling plans and requirements for Lead & Copper, residual disinfection levels, disinfection byproducts, asbestos and Nitrification to ensure compliance with State Statutes, the Clean Water Act and the Volusia County Health Department.</p> <p>Performs routine sampling of booster stations, interconnects and MRT sample site.</p> <p>Responds to Customer complaints and questions as it relates to water quality and other utility matters.</p> <p>Assists the Director, Water Plant Manager and Field Operations Superintendent with Precautionary Boil Water notices in compliance with the City's written plan and the Volusia County Health Department.</p> <p>Provides monthly report of water usage and residual levels to Water Plant Manager.</p> <p>Foster positive employee relations and employee morale on a City-wide basis.</p> <p>May be required to return to work to assist with emergency management preparation, response and/or recovery activities.</p> <p>Any other duties that may be assigned.</p>
