

NOTICE RESURFACING PROJECT

City of Edgewater has contracted with Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc. to Resurface your roadway. The resurfacing will be a two-step process, after the final step is complete the road will have a smooth black appearance. The work will cause minor delays and inconveniences. During work hours, limited access to the roads will be maintained. Access to roads will be coordinated by the workers onsite and people directing traffic. During non-working hours, you will have full access to the roads being re-surfaced.

To ensure the work can be performed, the following is necessary:

- 1. PLEASE ENSURE NO VEHICLES, BOATS, TRAILERS, DEBRIS, ETC. ARE LEFT IN THE ROADWAY FROM 7:00 AM TO 7:00 PM.
- 2. ALL IRRIGATION SYSTEMS NEED TO BE TURNED OFF DURING WORK HOURS. (7:00AM TO 7:00PM)
- 3. THE WORK WILL BEGIN BY FIRST APPLYING OIL AND STONE (CHIPS). A FEW DAYS LATER THE MICRO-SURFACING "COVER" COURSE WILL BE PLACED. BETWEEN THESE TWO PROCESSES THERE MAY BE SOME LOOSE AGGREGATE. PLEASE TRAVEL SLOWLY UNTIL THE FINAL COVER COURSE IS PLACED. SEVERAL WEEKS AFTER THE COVER HAS BEEN PLACED THE ROADS WILL BE SWEPT.
- 4. PLEASE OBEY ALL TRAFFIC PATTERNS AND FLAGGERS.

Directly after micro-surfacing and for a few days thereafter, try to limit turning your wheels on the new surface while not in motion. Turning while the vehicle is moving will prevent what are known as power steering burns on your newly paved roads, and is good practice in the future to prolong tire life. If you do notice a power steering burn, don't worry. These blemishes are strictly aesthetic and fade over time.
